

GLOW IN THE DARK ECC HUNT FAMILY DEVOTION

Share this family devotion with your families as part of an at-home glow in the dark egg hunt! This free download helps families learn about how Jesus is the light as they enjoy an at-home egg hunt in the dark.

Here's how it works:

- 1) Provide families with the supplies they need for a glow-in-the-dark egg hunt or encourage them to turn off the lights and hunt for eggs in the dark using flashlights.
- 2) Encourage families to host their own glow-in-the-dark egg hunt at home, then complete the attached devotional!

GLOW IN THE DARK EGG HUNT DEVOTION

Turn off the lights in your house and have a glow in the dark egg hunt as a family. You can either make your eggs glow using glow sticks or search for eggs in the dark using a flashlight. Take turns hiding and hunting the eggs for everyone.

After you find your glowing eggs, keep the lights off and use a flashlight to [read John 8:12](#) together as a family. Then talk about:

- What does this verse say about Jesus? (It said Jesus is the light of the world!)
- What does this verse say about those who follow Jesus? (If we follow Him, not only will we not walk in darkness, but we will have that light too!)
- How do we get/have the light of Jesus? (We have to believe that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for us on the cross to wash away our sin, and that He rose again 3 days later, defeating sin and death. That's what we celebrate at Easter!)

Jesus promised His followers that they would be lights too. Read [Matthew 5:14-16](#) together as a family. You hid the glowing eggs around the house (and maybe even under a bowl), but when we are followers of Jesus and we have His light, we shouldn't hide it!
