Introduction

In this book are fifty-two Bible verses your children can learn. All verses are from the King James Version of the Bible. The verses are arranged in the order they appear in the Bible, but they can be memorized in any order.

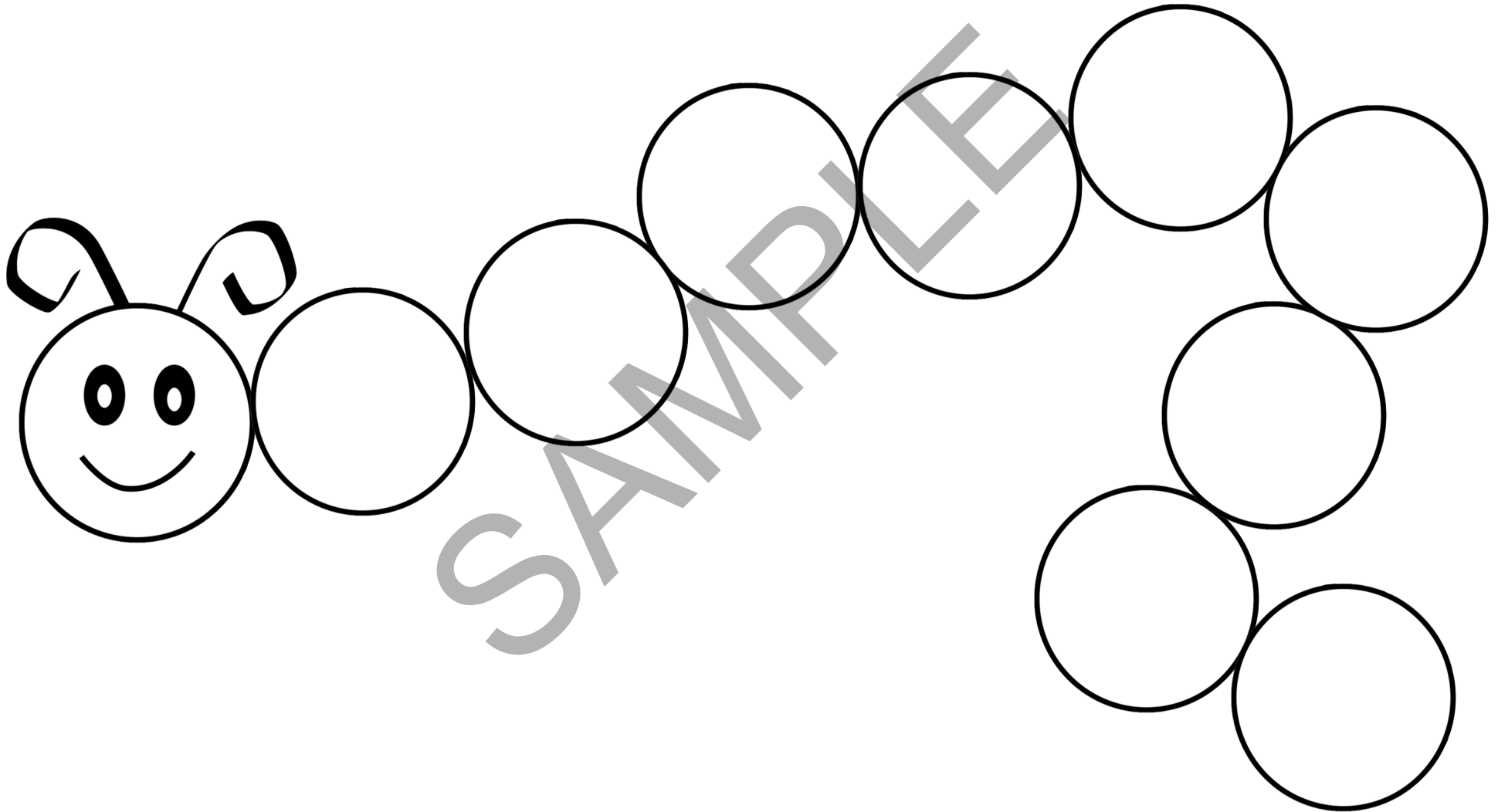
There are two types of pages in this book. The first type of worksheet page includes the Bible verse and a caterpillar with enough “body parts” to paste the parts of the verse. After two of these worksheet pages is a page that includes the body parts to cut out for the preceding worksheet pages.

You may choose to have each child practice the week’s verse each day. During the week, the children can color the parts of the caterpillar that have the words to the verse. They can also color the caterpillar’s head on the page with the verse. At the end of the week or the beginning of the next week, when the children can say the verse, help them cut out and arrange the parts so that the words are in the correct order. After the words are arranged, the children can paste them in the correct places to show that they have learned the verse. The pages with the Bible verse caterpillars can then be saved in a notebook or displayed on the wall to for the children to show their progress in memorizing Bible verses and for easy review.

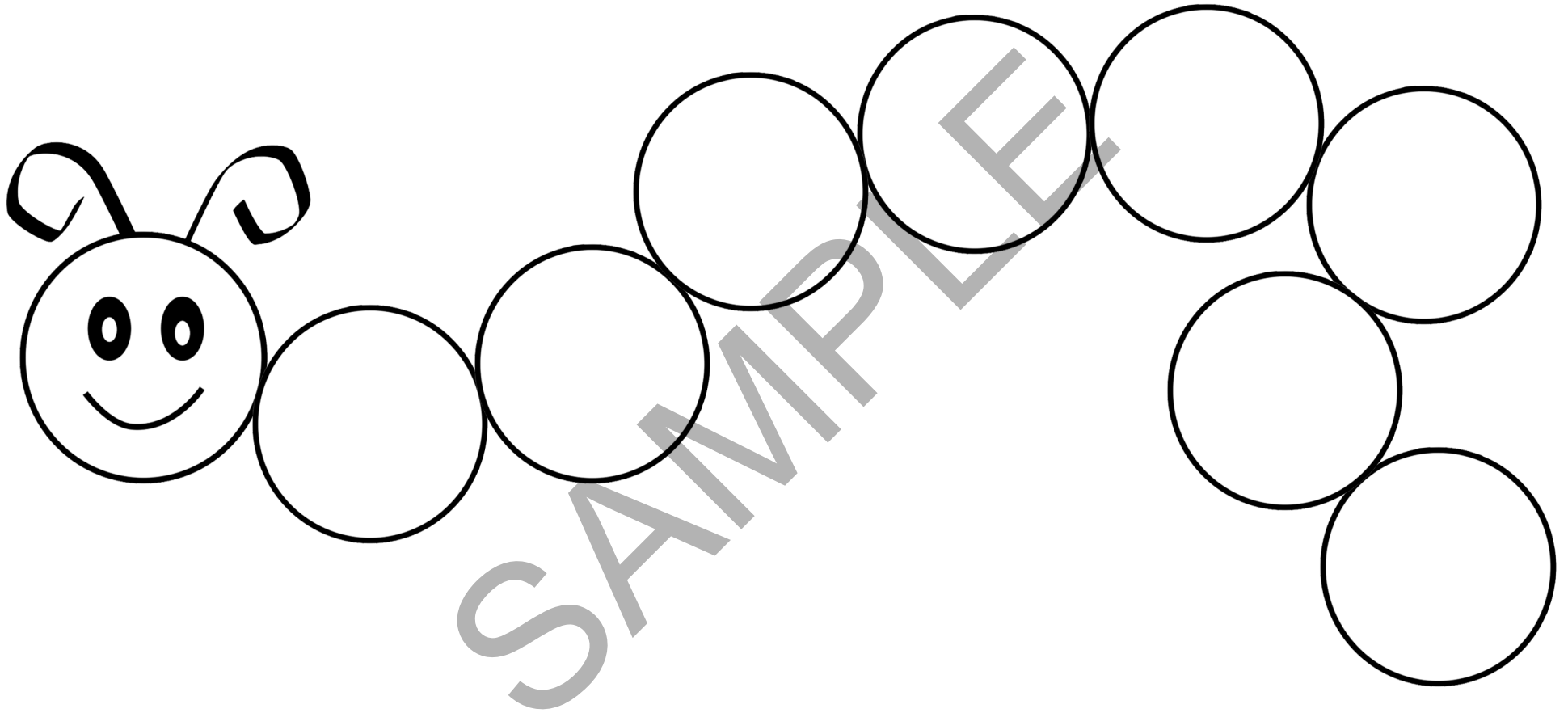
The Table of Contents shows all the verses studied in this book so you can easily find a particular verse. It also shows the length of each verse at a glance. If you’d like, you can start with shorter verses and increase the length and difficulty as the children grow in confidence in their ability to memorize the verses. There is one verse especially included for Easter, which you will find on page 37, and two verses are included especially for Christmas, which you will find on pages 43 and 45.

The options for using the book are nearly endless. However you find to use this book, I pray it will be a blessing to you and to the children you teach.

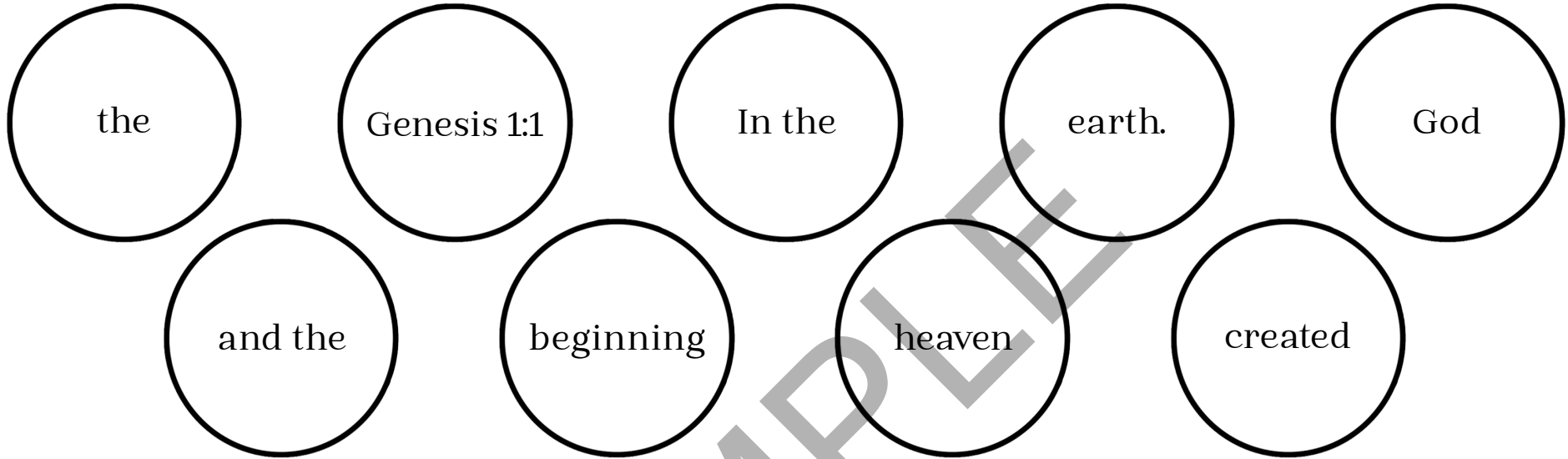
