

God Creates Adam

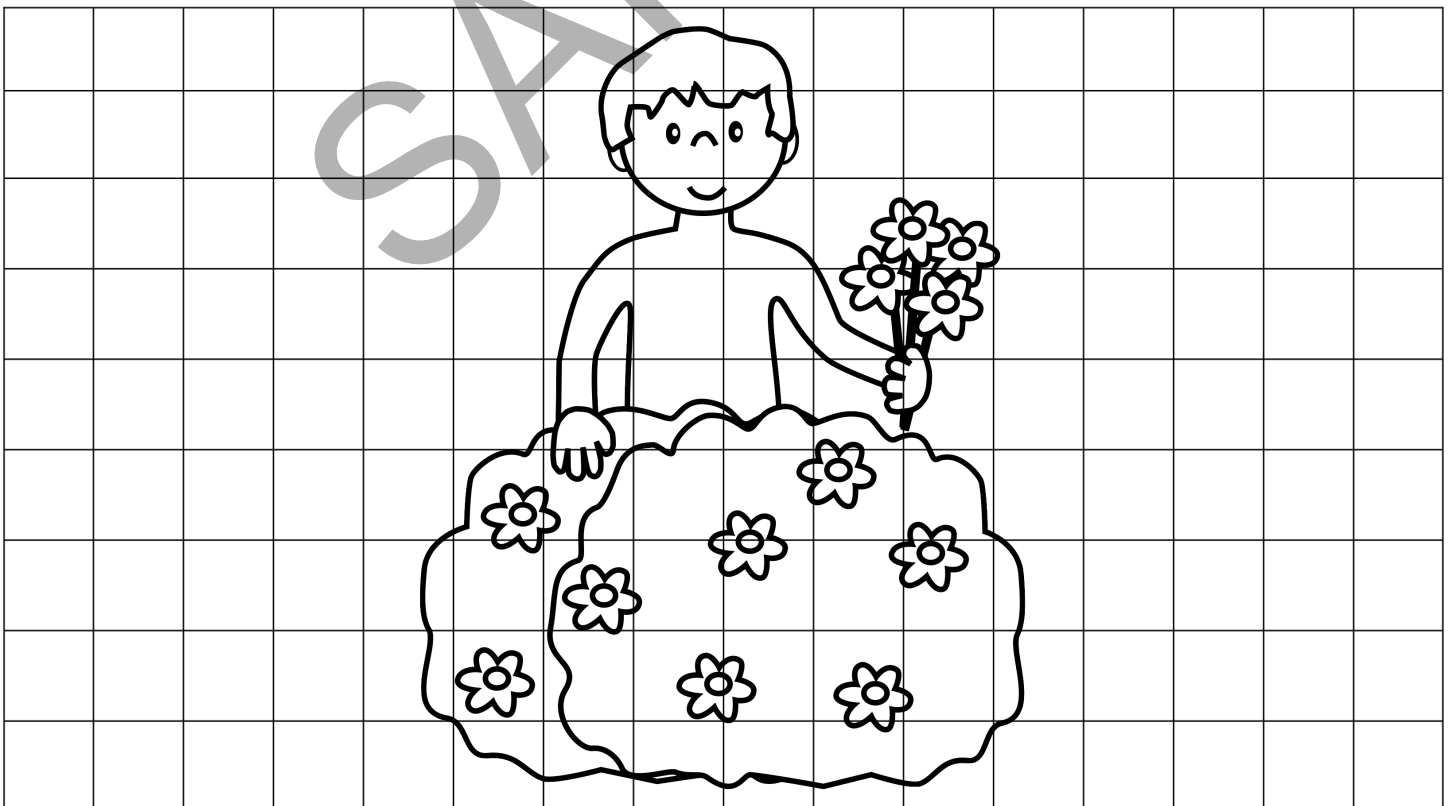
On the sixth day of Creation, God created man. He placed him in the Garden of Eden with only one command to obey—he must not eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

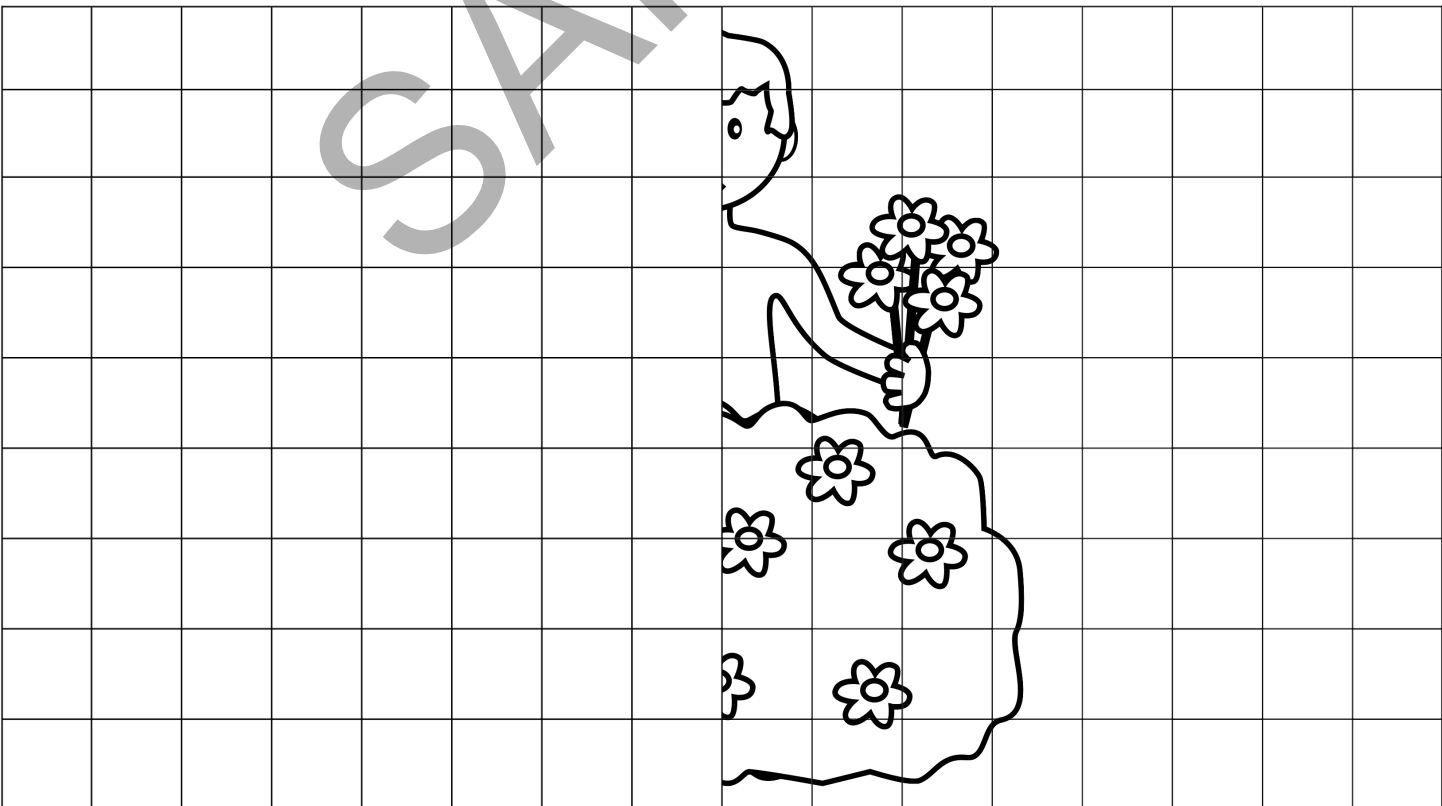
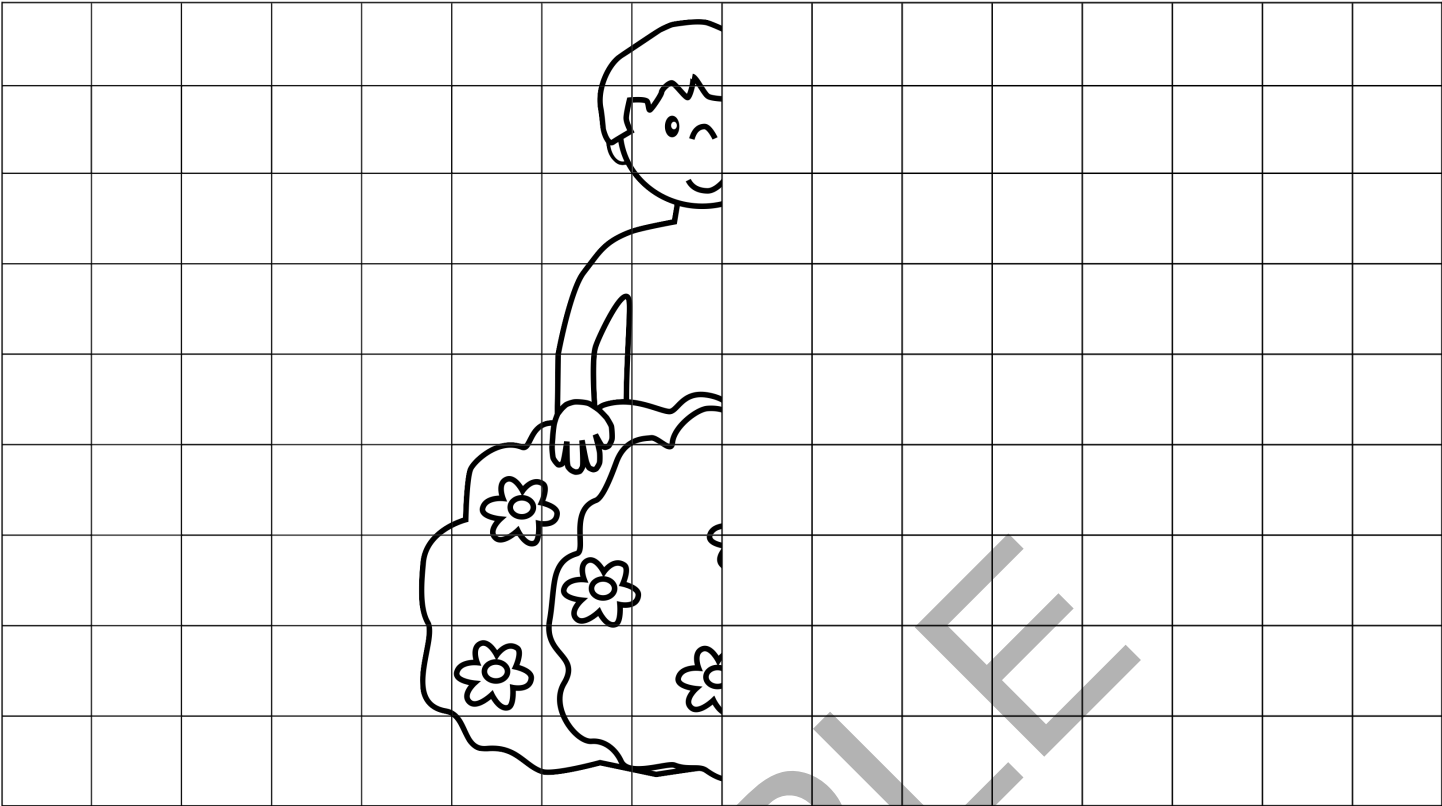

- Now, using a blank grid, try drawing the whole picture.

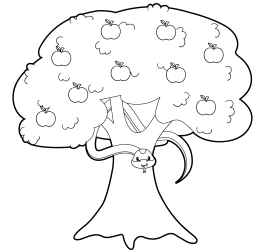
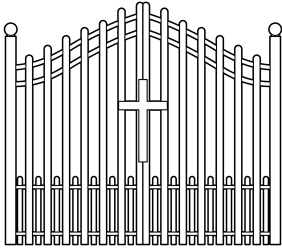




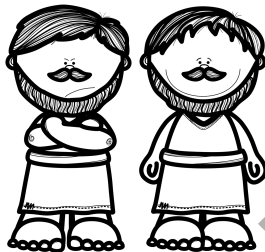

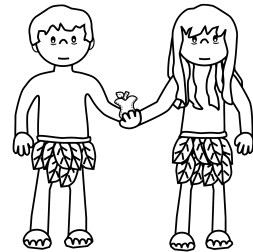
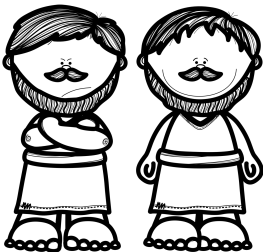
1. Which picture represents "Adam and Eve Are Put Out of the Garden of Eden"? Circle it.



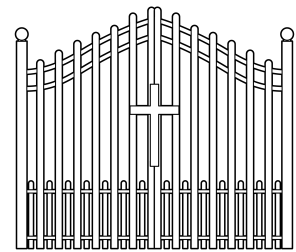
2. Which picture represents "Adam and Eve Have Sons"? Circle it.



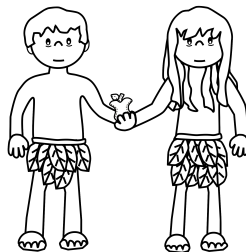
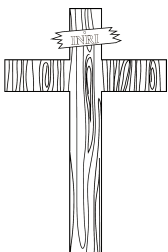

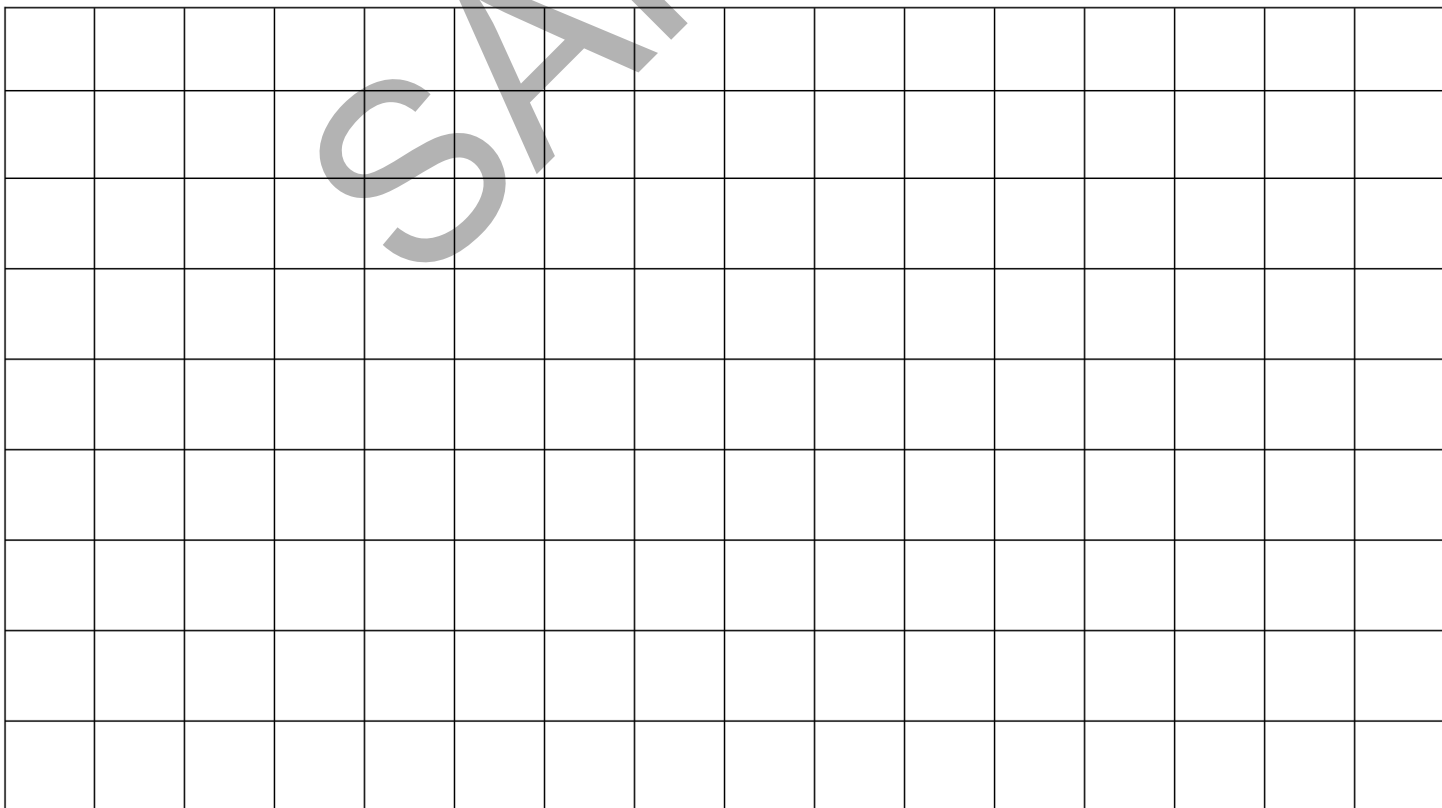
Chronological Order

Look at the pictures below. They each represent an event in the life of Adam and Eve. Put a number on the line next to each event to show the order they happened in.



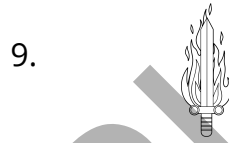
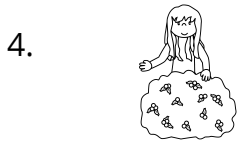
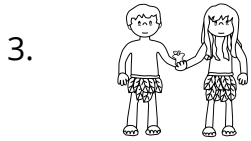
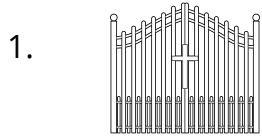
