

Creation: Day 5, Life in the Water and the Air

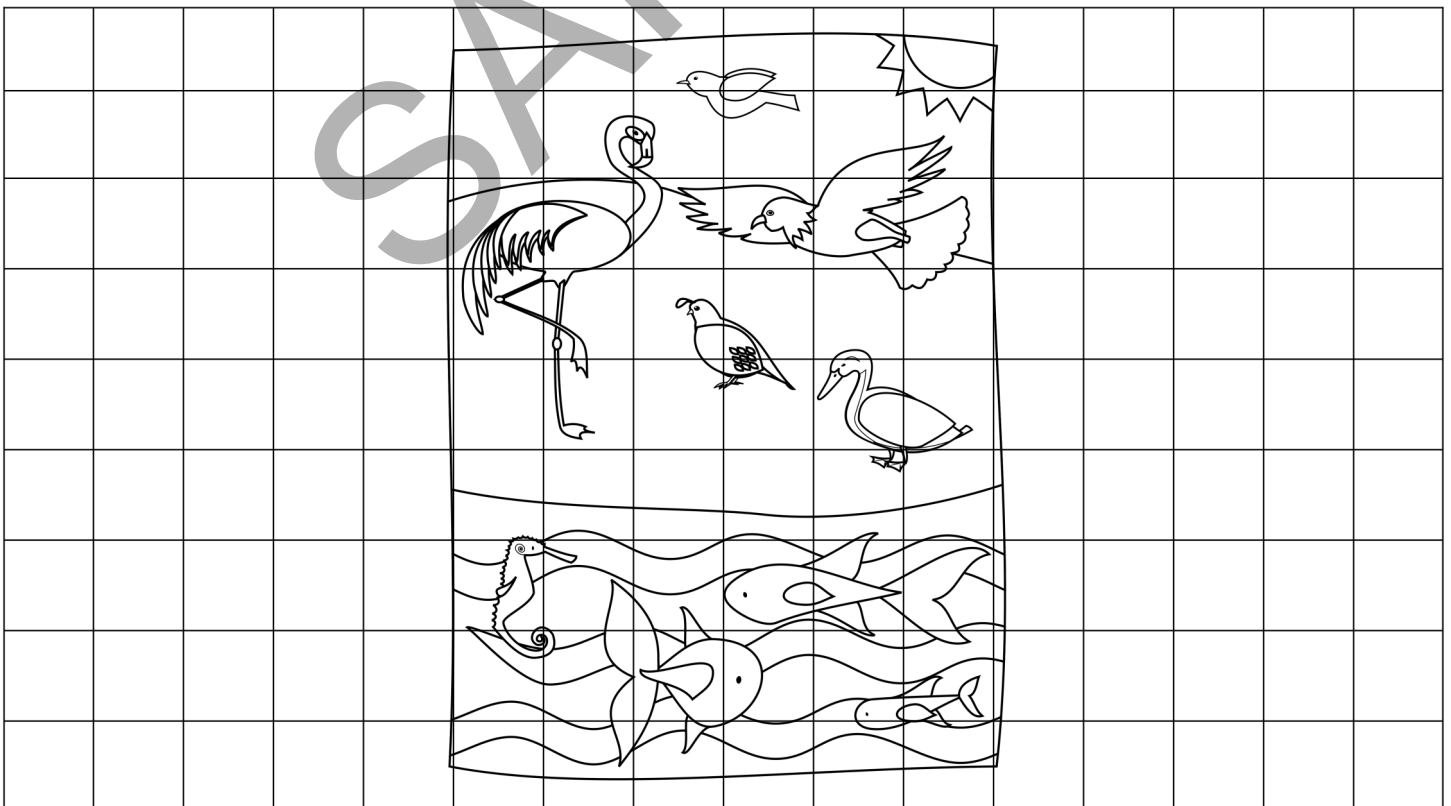

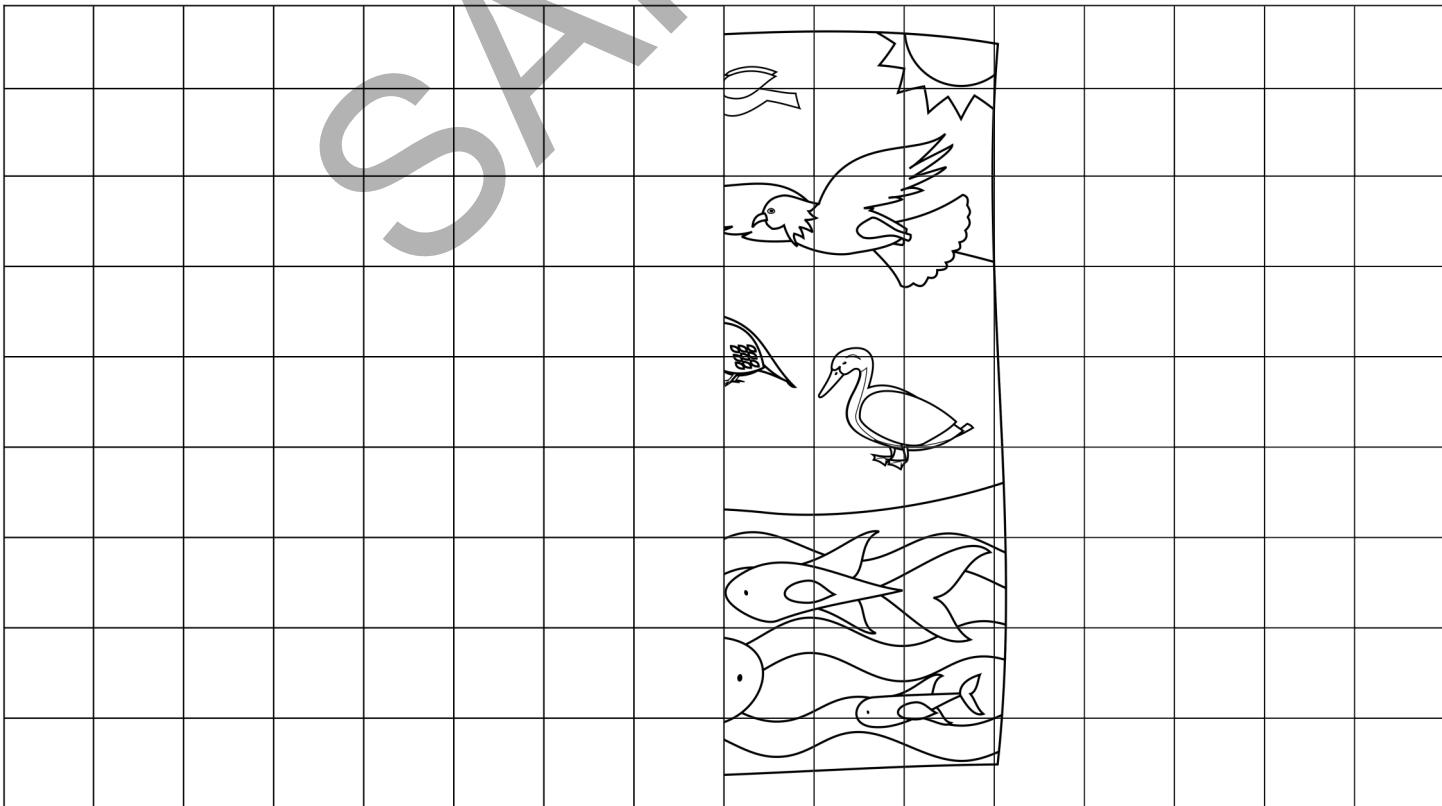
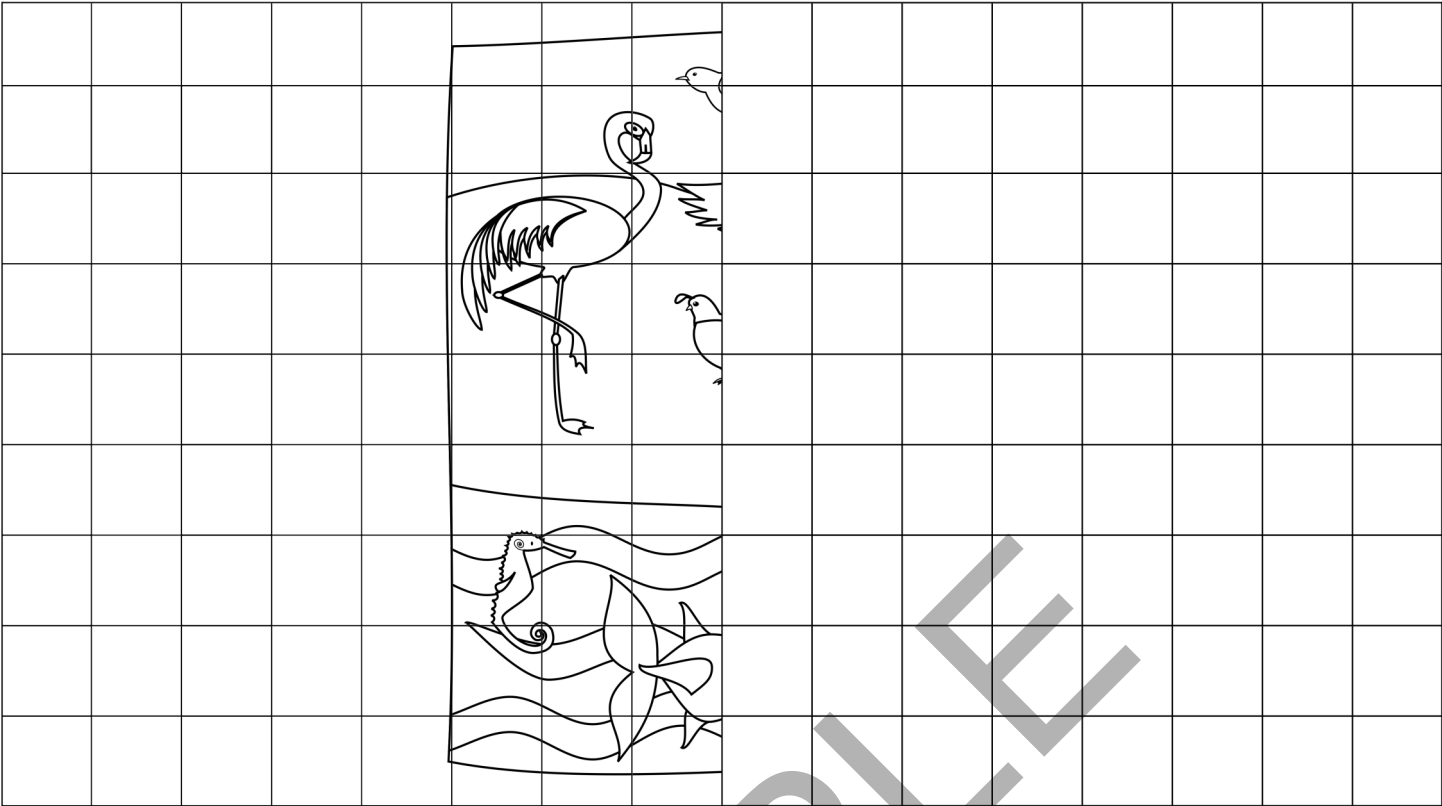
And God said, "Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven."

Follow these instructions to draw a picture representing Creation: Day 5, Life in the Water and the Air like the one shown below:

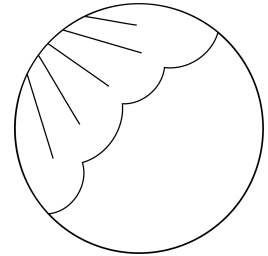
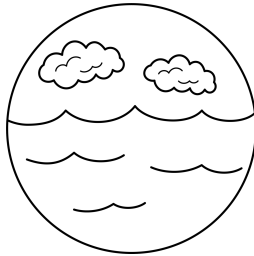
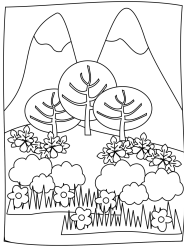

- Now, using a blank grid, try drawing the whole picture.



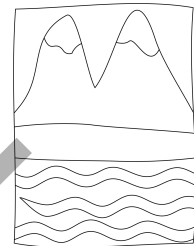
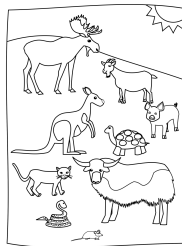
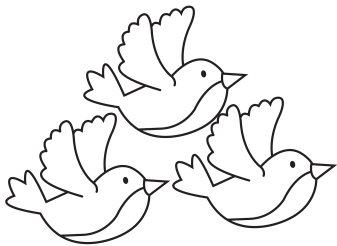

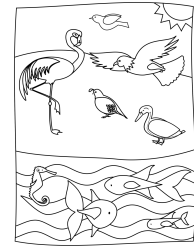
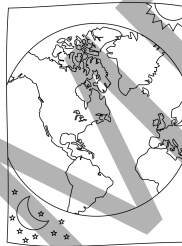
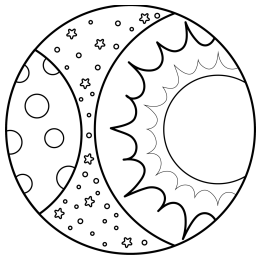
1. Which picture represents "Creation: Day 3, Plants"? Circle it.



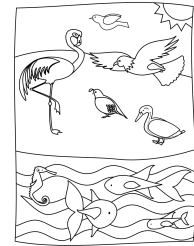
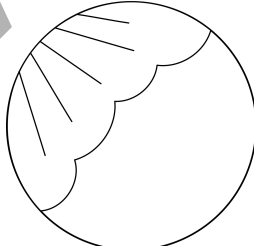
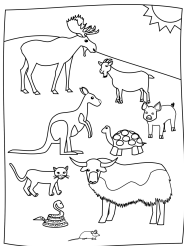
2. Which picture represents "Creation: Day 6, God Creates Land Animals"? Circle it.



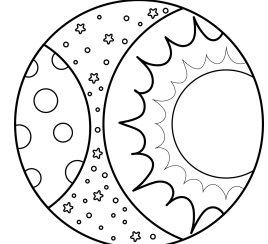
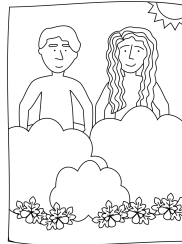
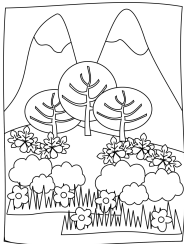
3. Which picture represents "Creation: Day 5, Life in the Water and the Air"? Circle it.

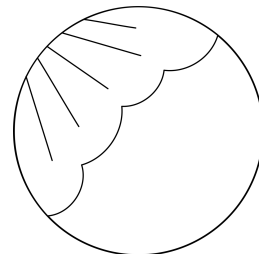
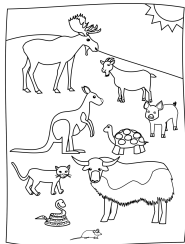
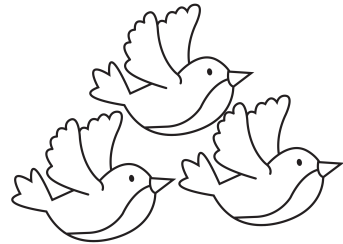
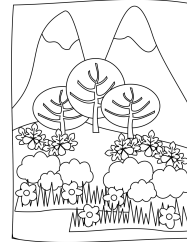
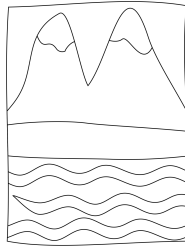
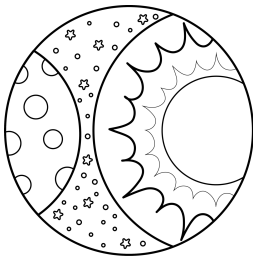
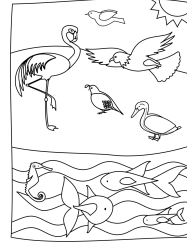


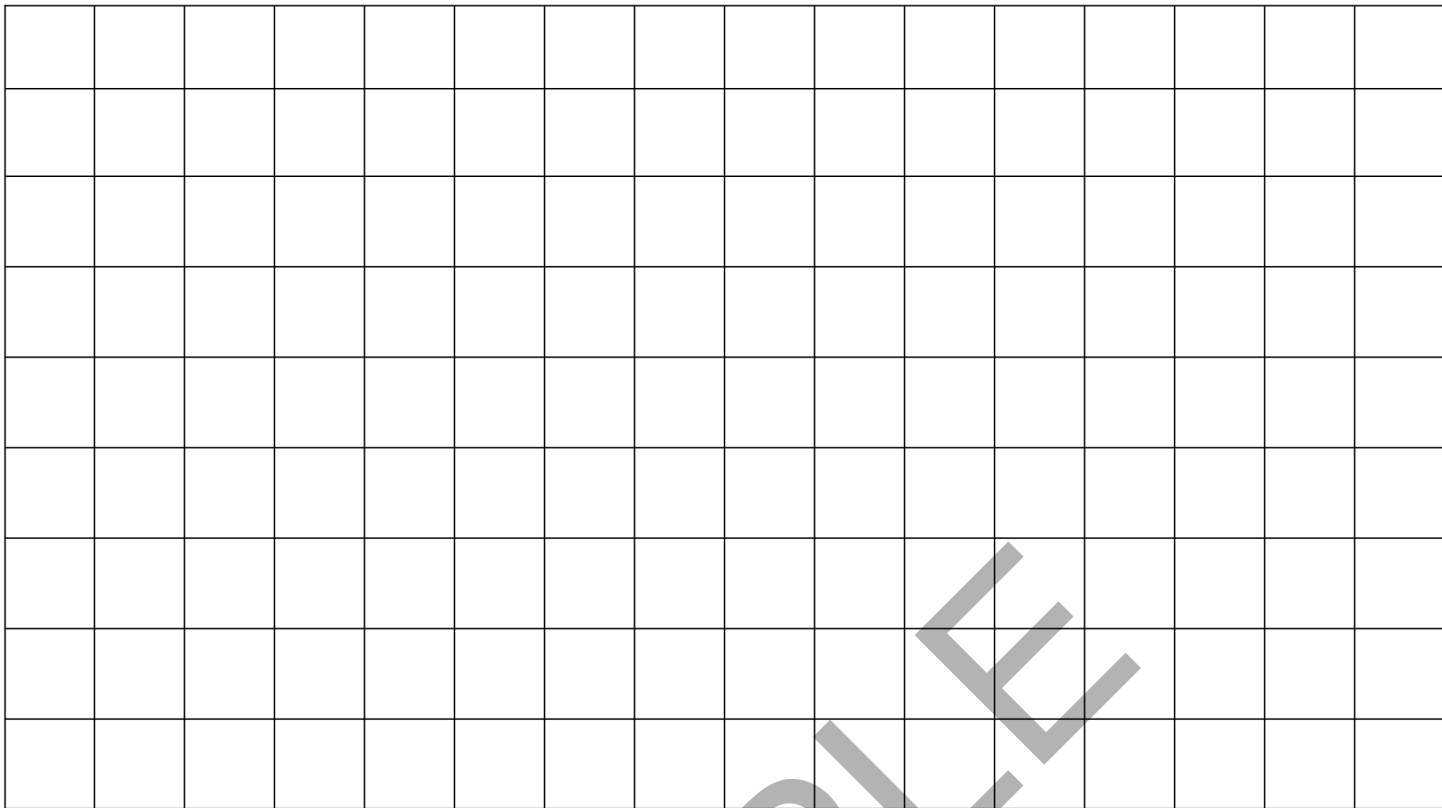
5. Which picture represents "Creation: Day 4, God Creates the Sun, Moon, and Stars"? Circle it.



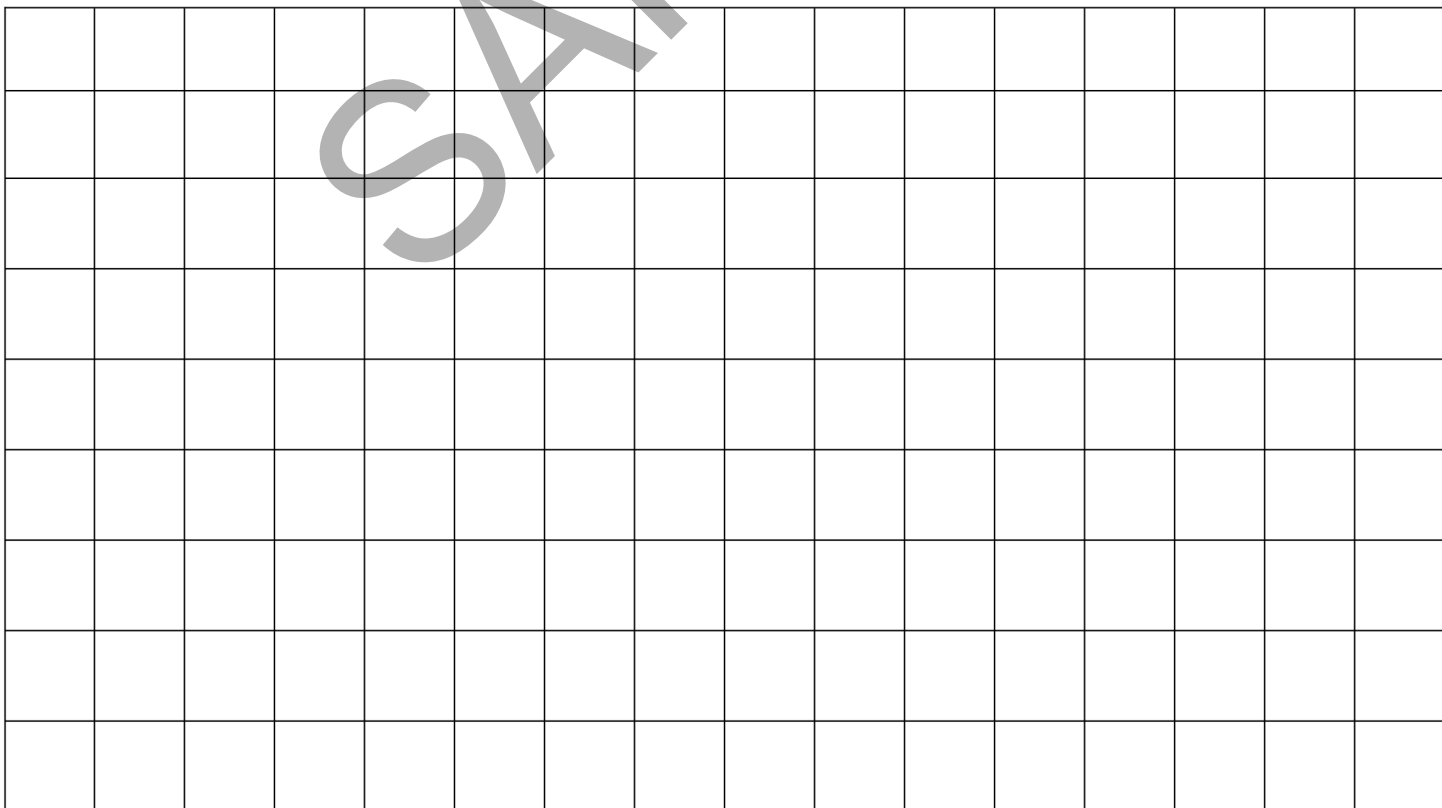
Chronological Order

Look at the pictures below. They each represent part of the Days of Creation. Put a number on the line next to each event to show the day they happened on.



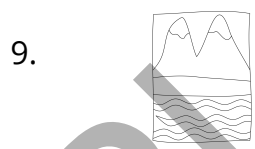
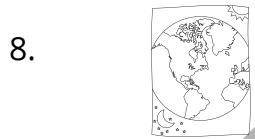
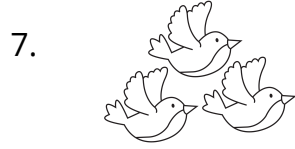
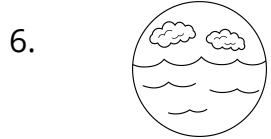
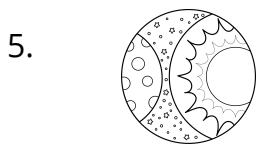
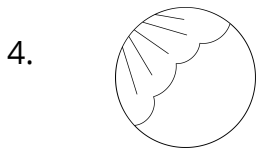
