

Joseph's Coat of Many Colors

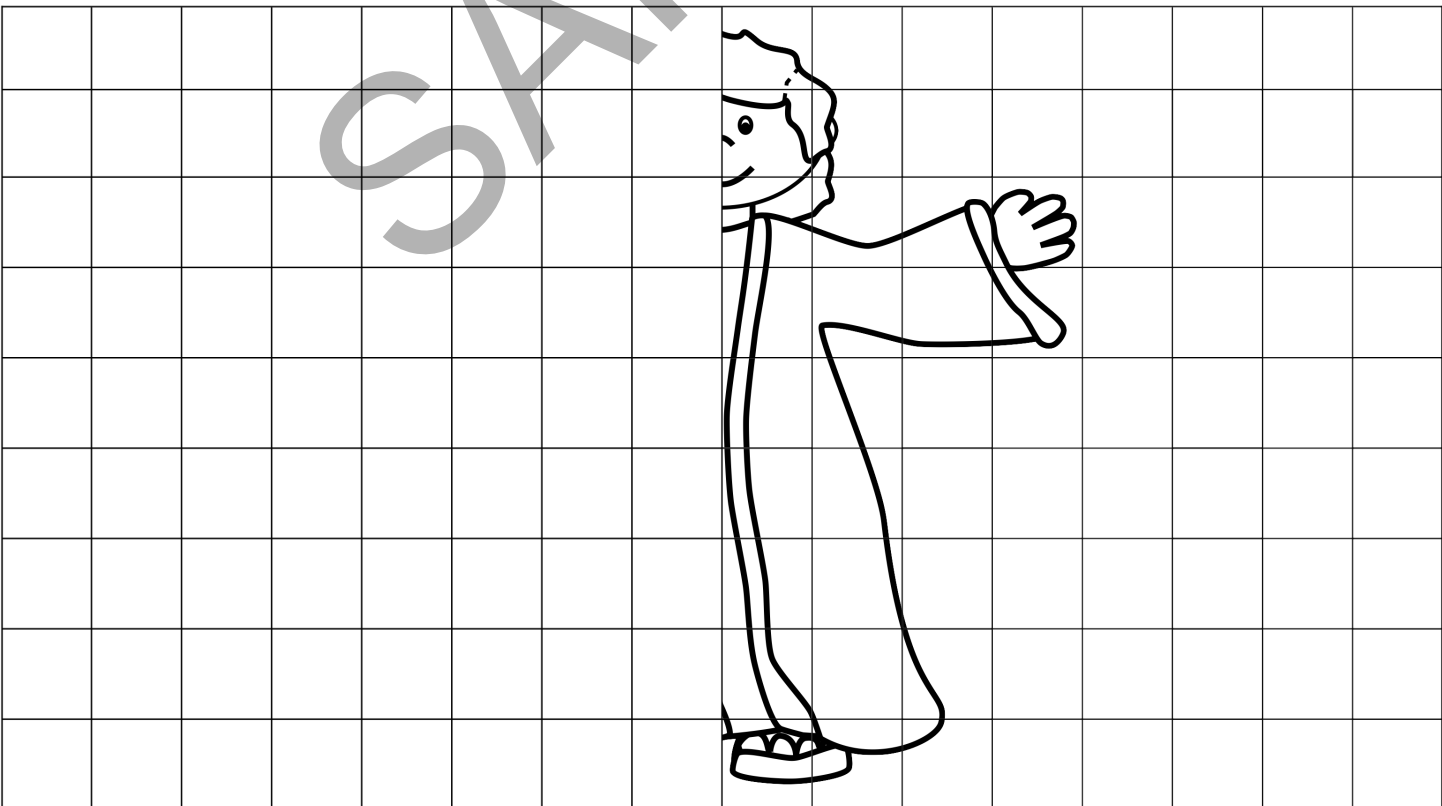
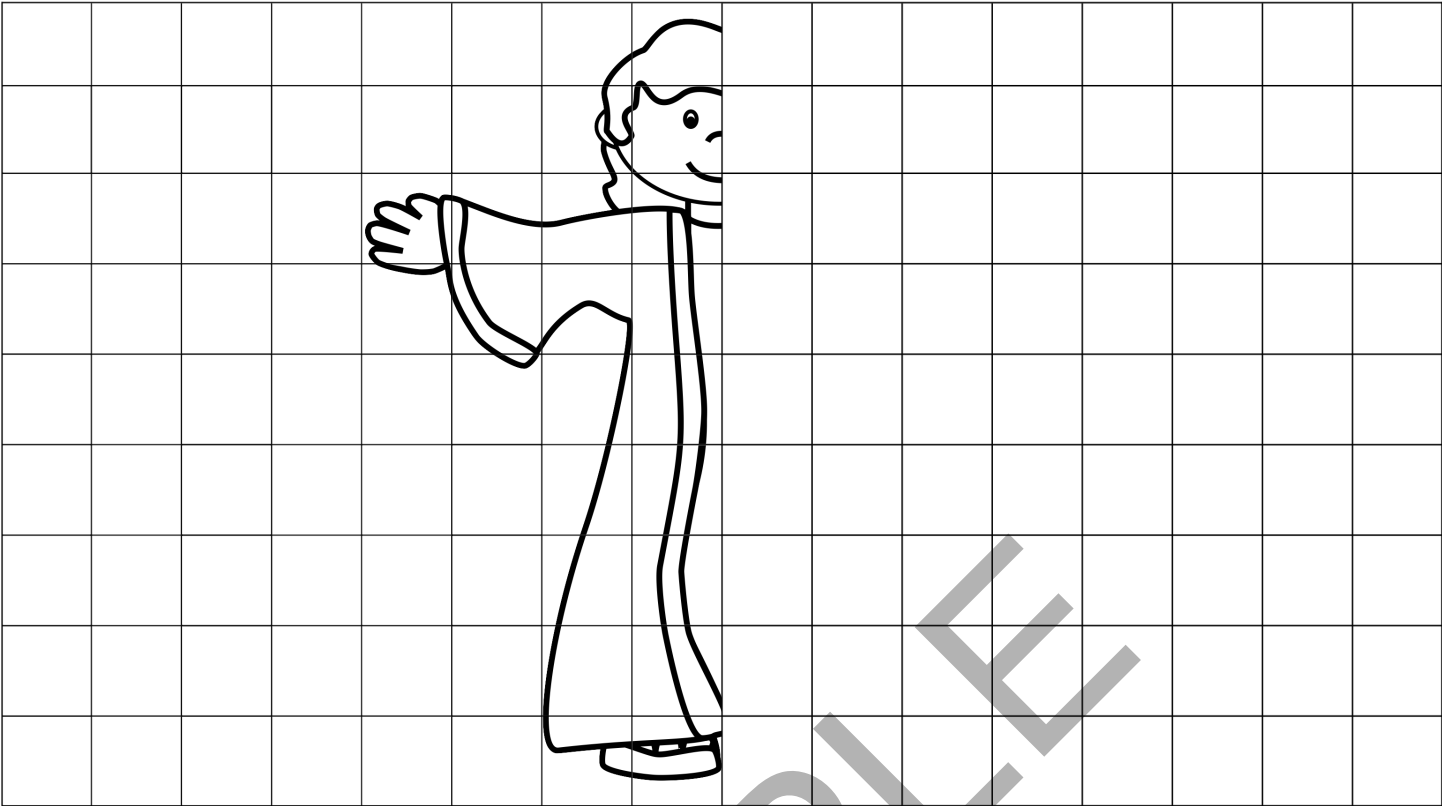

Follow these instructions to draw a picture representing Joseph and his coat like the one shown below:

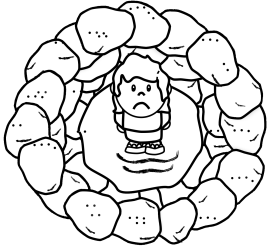

- Now, using a blank grid, try drawing the whole picture.



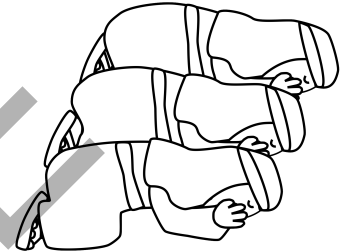
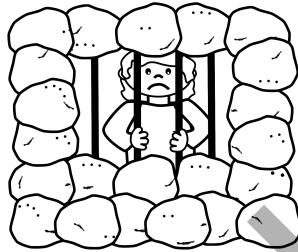
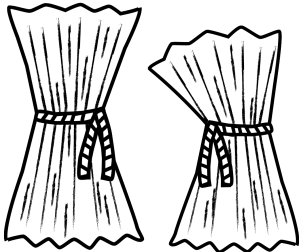

1. Which picture represents "Joseph Thrown Into the Pit"? Circle it.



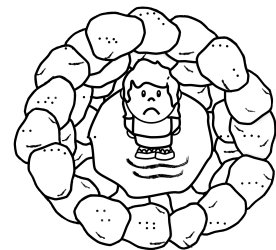
2. Which picture represents "Joseph's Brothers Bow Before Him"? Circle it.



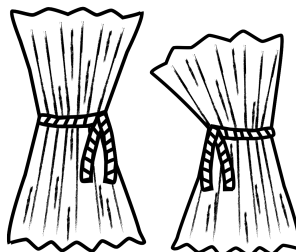
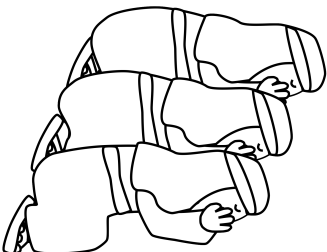

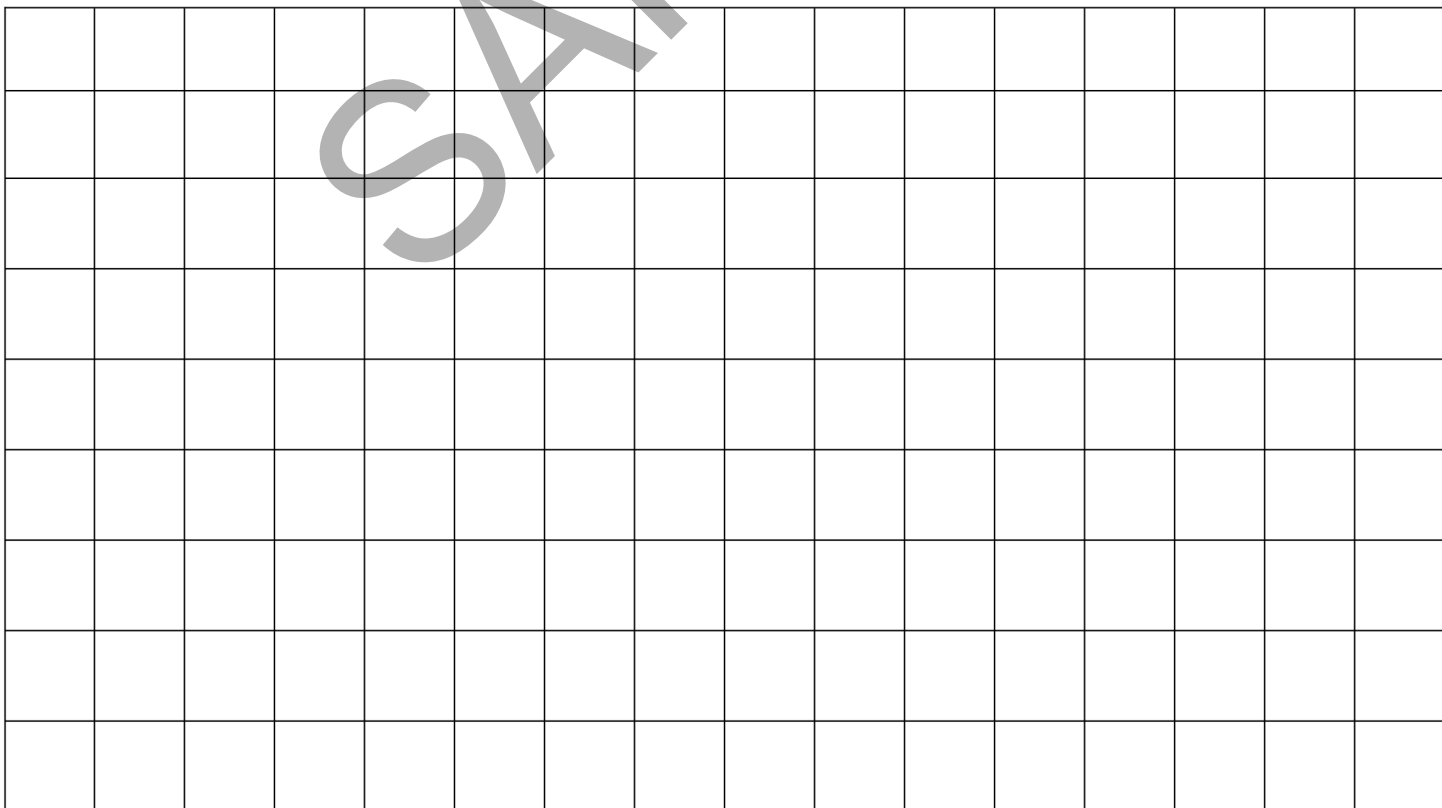
Chronological Order

Look at the pictures below. They each represent an event in the life of Joseph. Put a number on the line next to each event to show the order they happened in.



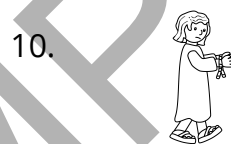
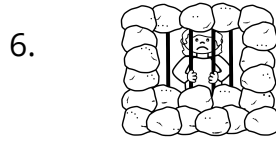
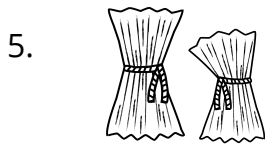
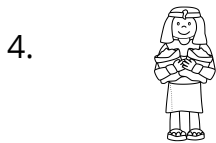
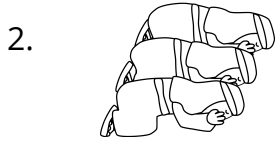
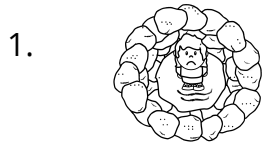
