



# Coastal Creations

## Crafts



### BIG IDEA

We can share Jesus with everyone!

### BIBLE

Jesus calls the disciples  
“fishers of men”  
Luke 5:1-11; Matthew 4:18-22

#### CRAFT: CATCH A FISH

- **Supplies:**

- Paper plate
- Colorful cupcake liners
- Googly eyes
- Watercolor paint or dot markers
- Construction paper
- Glue
- Scissors



- **Instructions:**

- Take a paper plate and paint it all one color with watercolor paints, or color it in with dot markers. (These dry faster, but if you are worried about time, you can pre-paint the plates, buy colored plates, or leave them white).
- Cut out a triangle piece for the mouth. Tape or glue that piece to the back for the tale.
- Glue a googly eye near the mouth.

**CRAFT: CATCH A FISH**

- **Instructions:**
  - Fold cupcake liners and begin gluing them as scales, starting at the tale and working towards the mouth.
  - On the back of the fish, write one of the following:
    - “Come, follow me”
    - “Fishers of men”
    - We can share Jesus with everyone!
  
- *During or after students make their fish, review today’s Bible story.*
- *Today’s Bible story comes from Matthew 4:18-22 - Jesus calls the disciples to be “fishers of men”.*
  
- In today’s Bible lesson, we learned about the time when Jesus called the disciples and told them to follow him and that they would become “fishers of men”.
- We are called to the same thing today! Following Jesus means putting our faith and trust in him, believing that he is God and that he came to earth to offer us salvation and a way back into a right relationship with God. It also means listening to what he says and acting the way Jesus acted.
- When we know and follow Jesus, we are also called to be “fishers of men”. This means that we share the good news of Jesus’s love with everyone we know! Just like the disciples, we don’t keep this amazing news to ourselves, but we share God’s love with everyone.
